





Located within minutes of the M1 pacific motorway. Short walk to local parks and golf course. Close to schools, shops, and train station.


Affordable housing and easy access to major highways will see its local population more than double to 50,000 over the next 10 years.

TRANSPORT



Tanderra is conveniently located 1km from the M1 Pacific Motorway. In less than an hour, locals can be cooling down on a Newcastle beach or exploring Sydney's northern suburbs.

Morisset's efficient public transport system allows residents to spend less time behind the wheel. Tanderra is less than two kilometres from Morisset train station, on the main train line between Sydney and Newcastle.

Morisset train station also serves as a Hunter Valley Buses terminus. Daily services connect Morisset with Cooranbong, Silverwater, Bonnells Bay, and Yarrawonga Park. Additional Friday services allow locals to visit Wangi Wangi or shop up a storm at Lake Haven Shopping Centre. Every weekday, Hunter Valley Buses also runs services to Toronto. Hunter Valley Buses' fleet is complemented by Rovers Coaches, which take residents from Morisset to the Wine Country centres of Cessnock and Kurri Kurri.

EDUCATION



Tanderra residents can walk to Morisset Public School in less than 10 minutes, and Morisset High School in just a little longer. There are also a number of other schools in the local area which cater for students of all ages:

- Heritage College Lake Macquarie
- Bonnells Bay Public School
- Avondale College of Higher Education
- Brightwaters Christian College



Tanderra is just a short drive from Morisset's main shopping precinct, which features the Morisset Square complex and the Dora Street shopping strip. Morisset Square is the ideal place for everyday shopping trips, with a Coles supermarket, Target Country, pharmacy, post office, newsagency, fresh and fast food outlets, and a small selection of specialty stores offering everything that locals need. Residents will find more shopping options along Dora Street, which boasts a Woolworths supermarket, newsagency, pharmacy, bottle shop, florist, pet shop, and much more.

Residents can make their Tanderra estate property a home in Morisset's industrial estate, which has a range of appliance outlets, home improvement solutions, and other retail providers.



The Morisset branch of Waratah Medical Services is an easy threeminute drive from Tanderra. Male and female doctors at this family-friendly clinic specialise in general health services, women's health, immunisations, antenatal care, weight management, mental health, and skin care. In addition, the practice also has physiotherapy, hydrotherapy, and X-ray facilities.

Bonnells Bay Surgery, inside the nearby Bay Shopping Centre, allows locals to attend to their medical needs on their regular shopping trip. There are generally at least three doctors, one or two nurses, and a clinical psychologist, an audiologist, and a podiatrist on the premises at all times.

Wyong Hospital, half an hour from Morisset, is the area's closest general public hospital. Its emergency room, cancer care centre, obstetrics department, rehabilitation ward, outpatient services, and coronary care and dialysis units offer the services locals with serious health complaints need.

LIFESTYLE



Tanderra's recreational facilities encourage residents to get outside and enjoy the great outdoors. Home owners can stroll in safety on pedestrian paths or enjoy a game on the community lawns. Bike racks in the common areas encourage families to cycle, and the onsite playground gives local children a fun place to stretch their

There's also plenty to do just outside Tanderra's gates. It's a short walk to Bernie Goodwin Memorial Park, which has a children's playground and fenced dog zone. The park is also home to Morisset Swimming Pool, which has a children's wading pool and heated outdoor 15-metre and 25-metre pools for year round play. Morisset's country club, golf course, and PCYC provide more recreational opportunities for local residents.
