## Thornton NSW

Located 25kms from the CBD of Newcastle, in great proximity to Maitland, the Central Coast and the Hunter Valley Vineyards, Thornton is the epicentre of the region’s fastest growing area.

Commuters and families have a quick 14 min train ride to the University of Newcastle, 19 mins to the CBD and surrounding beaches, Thornton sits 5 mins from the M1 Pacific Motorway and 10 min to join the Newcastle Link Road & Hunter Expressway allowing a fast track to the Upper Hunter/New England areas and the bustling suburbs of Lake Macquarie.
