MATER PRIVATE HOSPITAL SPRINGFIELD - 8 MINUTES FROM VERONA

The new \$85 million Mater Private Hospital providing 80 inpatient beds, operating theatres, inpatient wards, day surgery units and a cancer care centre. Approximately 70% of employees live in the greater area*.

IPSWICH HOSPITAL EXTENSION - 15 MINUTES FROM VERONA

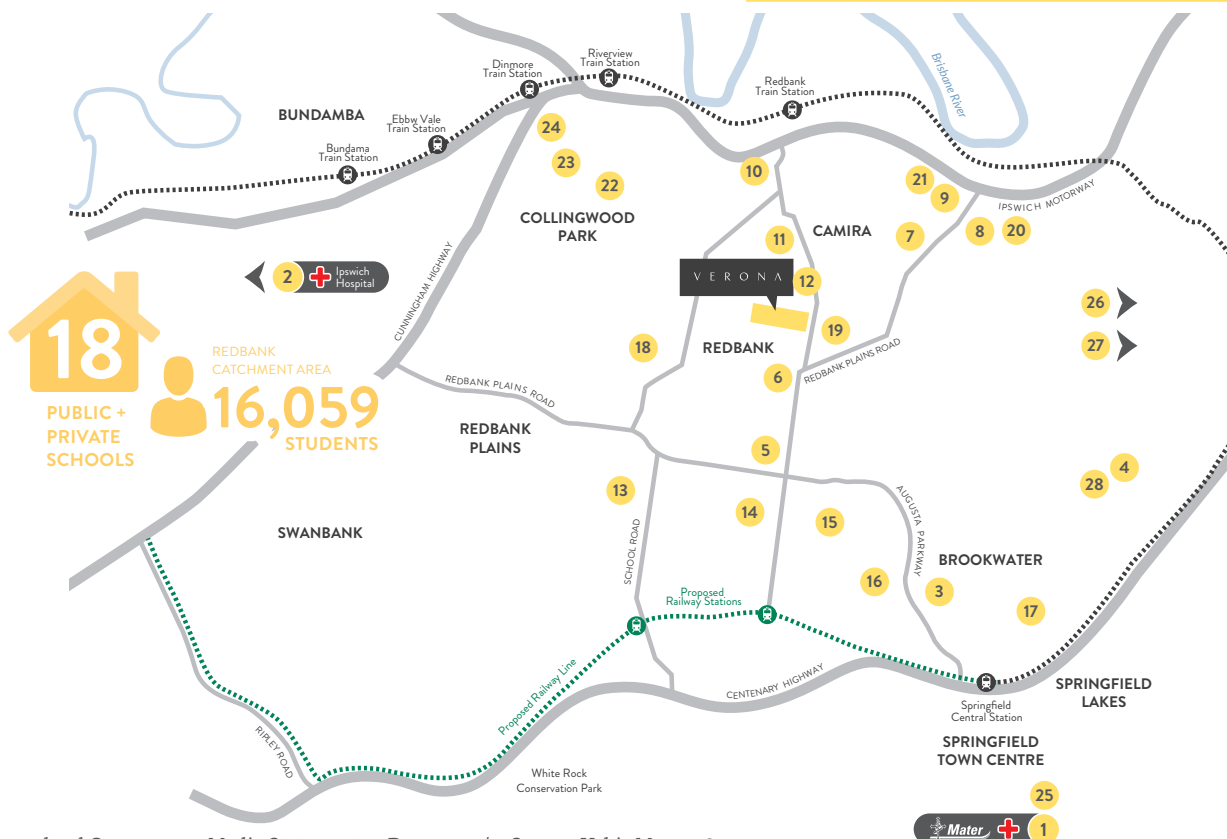
The recently completed \$128 million Ipswich Hospital expansion provided an additional 90 inpatient beds, dedicated paediatric services and clinical and non-clinical support facilities. This is the largest western district hospital in South East Queensland.

EDUCATION
