

EUCALYPTUS SIDEROXYLON ROSEA (RED FLOWERING IRONBARK)

Like many of the flora you'll find in Botanical, this flower is indigenous to Australia and perfectly adapted to our unique climate. Look out for its fuchsia flowers in winter and early spring.

KOELREUTERIA PANICULATA (GOLDEN RAIN TREE)
